What is Team Unified Vintage Brewoff?

Team Unified Brewoff is a three-person team event. Each team is given a pool of 10 sets to build 3 decks with completely unique cards to compete against other similar teams in a short tournament.

When is the event?

What are the legal sets?

For this event your team will receive 10 random sets from Alpha to 10th Edition. 2 of these sets will be core sets, while the other 8 will be expansions.

Banned Cards

In order to keep things fair between teams you are only allowed to use cards from your pool of 10 sets that are Legacy legal. However, in addition to your 10 sets you will also be given 15 singleton copies of otherwise banned cards in Legacy to split between your 3 decks. Because this exception is based on power level, cards banned for ante, dexterity, racism, ect. will not be included.

Are there any banned cards?

Do I need a team to sign up?
