- **Process for Registering For Off-Campus Programs**
 - Complete grade-level Registration Google Form. One of the questions on the form asks if you want to take an off-campus program. If you select Yes, they'll be able to enter the name of the program and the location they want to take it.
 - Register for the program's Placeholder class in IC. It will say something like "RCHS Fire Science Placeholder" for example, and it will be in the non-credit section of the planner in IC. We know this might be confusing, so we will be looking at the responses to the Google forms to make sure the correct placeholders are being added.
 - Complete the Program-specific application. There is a link to the PSR Registration site (with links to all the different applications) on the grade-level checklists. Or, a direct link here: <https://postsecondary.dcsdk12.org/registration>. These are due by February 27 for off-campus programs.
 - Your counselor will complete a recommendation form, where required.
 - Students will be notified on March 13 if they are accepted into a program.
- The PostSecondary Readiness department will be here on Thursday 1/15 during Access to talk about the different options available to students at Legacy Campus and other high schools. Anyone is welcome.
- Have conversations with your teachers about proper class placement between January 9th and January 20th so you are able to complete the process as easily and accurately as possible.
- Register for classes through the IC Portal in the Academic Planner beginning on January 9th. The registration portal will close at 7:00 a.m. on January 20th so no class choices will be taken after that date. You can access the [Portal Here](#).
- **Steps for registering ([tips and tricks doc](#)):**
 - Log In to Student Portal
 - Click on 3 Black Lines in Top Left Corner
 - Click on Academic Plan
 - Select the desired **Post Grad Location and Post Grad Plans**. Click **Next** button when finished.
 - Your Course plan will automatically load. Courses you have already

completed or are currently taking will automatically populate in your course plan.

- Select classes starting with your core classes (ie. go to English section and start typing a class in the empty box. If box is pre-loaded with a selection, please confirm that it is correct)
- Continue selecting classes until you have completed at least **6** full credits. (If you need/want more classes continue adding up until **7** credits)
- It will **not** automatically save your choice, scroll to the top and click **"Save"**
- Continue to the bottom of the page until you see the **"Alternates"** section. Please pick **4** alternate classes.
- Please reach out to your Homeroom teacher or Counselor if you have any questions. Counselors will be double-checking students' choices to make sure you signed up for enough and appropriate classes.
