### **EYL Exec Meeting**

The EYL exec are currently in the process of arranging a meeting to discuss the SE Co-option (have given applicants an extension till the end of friday to submit their statements), discuss plans for the general meeting and EYL reform at summer conference as well as to have a general check in before the May elections. I have also invited Alex Hartley to the meeting to see if there is anything the regional chairs feel they need from the new staff member. This meeting should be at some point next week.

### **Emergency English Council**

On the same day as our executive meeting, there will be a meeting of the full English Council. This meeting will tidy up the standing orders, ratify some changes to selection rules, appoint a replacement vice chair to the EAP and receive reports from reps and officers. The candidate is Kian Hearnshaw, former English Party Vice Chair and of course Young Liberal. He will receive our backing. Young Liberal EC reps have been invited to a pre-meeting before the meeting on saturday to discuss the agenda. I have been in touch with all our YL-elected EC reps and none seem to need any substitutes so I am expecting us to have 100% attendance again.

Additionally, we passed an amendment to F33 Supporting Hospitality, Retail and Leisure in the Face of Omicron, calling for the introduction of preferential duty rates for draught beer. Thank you to Eleanor Kelly for summating the amendment.

Following discussion with the executive, I have written a brief and opened applications for a working group on Ukraine, which will support Peter Banks' LYMEC work on the issue. I am also tasking the working group with updating the policy paper for submission to YL summer conference afterwards.

I am currently working on the YL consultation responses to the FPC working groups, and will be encouraging individual members to put in their own responses too.

Following YL winter conference, I have updated the policy book and spoken to Policy Committee to begin work on the motions which were referenced back. This accompanied discussions about how we will approach and support policy submissions to YL summer conference and federal winter conference.
