General Information

USA Learn's "1st English Course" is a 20-unit course rich in listening, speaking, reading, and writing activities. As English Language Learners progress through the course, they follow the story of Miguel and his classmates as they navigate their lives as newcomers to the United States. Miguel's English class, work, his children's school, and the doctor's office are common settings throughout the storyline, providing learners with exposure to the vocabulary, grammar forms, and cultural knowledge that are relevant to many adult ELL's lives. With reading comprehension questions that are focused on main idea and simple details, a grammar focus on common verbs and simple sentences, and conversation activities that build the students' ability to answer wh- and Y/N-questions, this course is suitable for learners functioning around descriptor level 2 (or NRS 3) of the English Language Proficiency Standards. Teachers will find that the ELPS most commonly addressed in this course are 1, 2, 3, 8, and 10.
