# FAQ's

### *Am I currently registered to vote?*

You can check by going to voterstatus.sos.ca.gov (voter status dot S-O-S dot ca dot gov). You can search with your name, birthdate, and drivers license or the last 4 of your SSN.

## Where can I get voter information if I don't have access to the internet?

You can call (800) 345-VOTE for more information.

## Can I still register to vote?

You can register to vote in the election until October 21st, 2024. You can register online at REGISTER TO VOTE dot C-A dot G-O-V [registertovote.ca.gov]

## When will I get my ballot?

Your county will begin mailing ballots on October 7th, 2024

## Can I return my ballot at a drop box?

Yes, you can return your ballot at any ballot drop box or drop off location in the state. Ballots returned at drop off locations must be dropped off by no later than 8 PM on election day, November 5th.

### Can I return my ballot on election day?

Yes, you can return your mail-in ballot at any polling place in the state by 8 PM on election day.

The general election is on November 5th, 2024.
