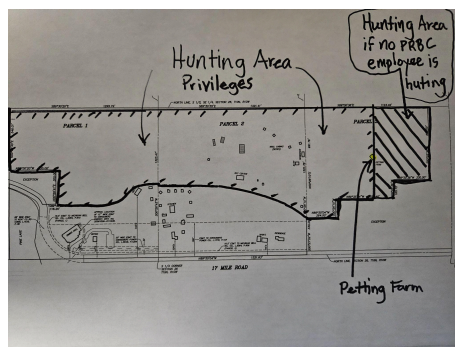


For the 2026 Deer Hunting season (Archery and Regular Firearm), and separately the spring Turkey Hunting season, Pine Ridge Bible Camp, located at 8415 17 Mile Rd. NE, Cedar Springs, MI will auction off hunting privileges. The following bullet points will be guides for what the privilege includes or limits.

The property itself is approximately 100 acres, with about half of the property considered huntable (because of homes and other building structures on-site). Pre-auction property inspections are permissible. Please contact Kevin Grifhorst through social media or kevin@pineridgecamp.com to get permission and arrange a time.

Concerning Deer Hunt:

- Pine Ridge reserves the right to exclude, for any reason, dates and times from the privilege. This will mostly be determined by any guest groups that stay on our property and have activities that could be out near hunting areas. Dates and times for 2026 are yet to be determined, but could include a once a month time period for a Wednesday - Friday, 10am-3pm each day as well as a few Saturday mid-morning through afternoon time slots.
- Pine Ridge would request that the hunters provide advance notification to the Camp Director for when hunters will be on the property so that our staff families living on-site will have this knowledge.
- A maximum of 4 hunters/blinds on the property at one time.
- A hold harmless agreement will be mandatory between Pine Ridge and any hunters on the property.
- The area of hunting privilege would include exclusive rights to approximately 55 acres of huntable land mostly along the northern 700 feet of property. However, Pine Ridge reserves a 5 acre section east of the petting barn/zoo for employees to hunt. The winning bidder can also hunt this 5 acre section if they check with Pine Ridge for employees actively hunting. A map with boundaries will also be provided at the auction.



Concerning Turkey Hunt:

- Pine Ridge reserves the right to exclude, for any reason, dates and times from the privilege. This will mostly be determined by any guest groups that stay on our property and have activities that could be out near hunting areas. Dates and times for 2026 are yet to be determined, but could include a once a month time period for a Thursday -

Friday, 10am-3pm each day as well as a few Saturday mid-morning through afternoon time slots. Also, the hunting season privileges will not extend past Memorial Day due to summer camp programs starting up on the property.

- Pine Ridge would request that the hunters provide advance notification to the Camp Director for when hunters will be on the property so that our staff families living on-site will have this knowledge.
- A maximum of 4 hunters/blinds on the property at one time.
- A hold harmless agreement will be mandatory between Pine Ridge and any hunters on the property.
