The Economic and Social Council,

Supports the creation of a new UN body named "United Nations Prisoner Entertainment Programme"(UNPEP) which takes 1% of the world's prisoners and forces them to write literary critiques of art, culture and music so that the world can be given free and accessible ratings of entertainment.

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Requires prisons to adopt a mandatory physical exercise programme coordinated by the International Hamster Activity Organization (IHAO) in which prisoners are subjected to 12 hours of weekly intensive hamster wheel trainings to produce energy for the prison itself, therefore decreasing maintenance costs and additionally increasing the general level of fitness amongst prison populations, to supplement their training, prisoners can request for “breakfast in wheel” on days they have long training; (USA is making speech)

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
