The Fair Share Campaign is Underway

We write to you with a great sense of purpose: a statewide campaign has begun to pass a graduated income tax in Massachusetts and raise a billion dollars to support public education and other essential public services. Yes!Northampton has a role to play in this important initiative.

This "fair share" tax proposal would amend the state Constitution to allow for a graduated income tax on millionaires - a 4% higher tax rate - which would generate \$1 billion in revenue dedicated to public education and public transit, roads and bridges.

We at Yes!Northampton are ready to deliver on the promise we made during the property tax override campaigns: we will work on progressive tax reform as the lasting solution to the problem of inadequate public funding for municipalities. While we needed those overrides as a last resort to preserve our community, regularly asking our citizens to fund an override is not sustainable. Now is the time to fight for our fair share.
