POWERS

- **Superhuman characteristics:** His body was made to essentially be an unstoppable force, and have senses that matched his physical prowess. Without using lightning to enhance himself, He can withstand 15 Tons of weight, Can fly at speeds well beyond supersonic, clocking in at 400 mph, and is resistant to conventional forms of harm. Even his brain operates better than normal humans, and it allows him to learn things at a much quicker rate than he does, often allowing him to understand complex concepts by just watching it work or be described as long as he has a general grasp on it. This doesn't mean he knows everything though.
- **Bio lightning:** being born with the power to generate lightning from his body, he is not only a great conductor of electricity/lightning, but he also can absorb it for more energy. He is able to shoot any kind of projectile you can think of, from small bolts to large AoE blasts. He can even create constructs, as demonstrated when he could make a forcefield around himself, or a blade that's completely made out of lightning. He can affect large areas with his lightning at max, but it will take a lot of energy out of him, and it will also take him a moment to recharge. At max, he could affect an entire city with his lightning attacks, but as described it will take a toll on his stamina. Since his lightning is biological and infused with his cells, he can regenerate wounds with his lightning as long as they aren't any of his organs besides his skin and bones, or severed limbs.
- **Partial self-sustenance:** doesn't require sleep, oxygen, or hydration at all. Oddly enough, he does need to eat however.
- **Electromagnetic manipulation:** Lightning generates magnetic fields, so controlling them was a natural extension he gained during the later years of his training and development. He can manipulate metal, create force fields, disrupt electronics in a wide area, or generate EMP pulses. The amount of metal he controls depends on their weight, and scales with his physical strength.

- Martial arts expertise: He is trained in the disciplines known as Boxing, Muay Thai, and Judo. He studied Krav maga but isn't an expert at it.
 - Mechanical engineer: Used his enhanced learning to gain a PhD level in expertise in this field
 - Gardening: He picked this up by watching humans grow plants, and having conversations with old and experienced gardeners.

Weaknesses
