

# 29.1 Ezekiel 33-36

Read Ezekiel 33:11, looking for Jehovah’s response to the Israelites’ concern.

---

What message about Himself did Jehovah instruct Ezekiel to communicate to the Israelites?

---

What did He instruct the Israelites to do?

Read Ezekiel 33:12–13, looking for what Jehovah taught about our righteousness (or righteous actions).

---

Read Ezekiel 33:14–16, looking for what happens to those who were wicked but turned from their sins.

---

Read Ezekiel 33:17–20, looking for what the people said about the way of the Lord, or the way He will judge us, and for the Lord’s response to the people.

1. Based on what you have studied in Ezekiel 33, what will be considered when we are judged?

2. Why do you think it is important to understand that Jesus Christ will judge us by the kind of person we have become as a result of our actions?

---

What are characteristics of a good shepherd?

Read Ezekiel 34:1–8, looking for what the Lord said about the leaders of Israel and their treatment of the people.

---

Read Ezekiel 34:11–16, looking for what blessings Jehovah promised His people as their shepherd.

3. a. What do we need to do to receive the blessings you found in Ezekiel 34:11–16?

b. When has the Savior been like a good shepherd to you by providing one of those blessings?

Read Ezekiel 36:24–28, looking for what the Lord promised to do for those who choose to follow Him in the last days.
