

MirrorOp for Windows

is software that allows you to

1. wirelessly present your laptop computer (Mac or Windows) on any display where you see this:



2. save and manage these connections for the rooms you use frequently.

Download MirrorOp

Open any browser. Enter: **go.stolaf.edu/mo**

Choose **Windows**.

Click: **MirrorOp for Windows**, then click the **Download** button.

Install MirrorOp

Run the MirrorOp installer from your Downloads folder.

When asked for administrator credentials:

For St. Olaf issued laptops running Windows 10:

Enter username: **.\admin**

The password needed is the same password as you use for Bitlocker (the blue screen you occasionally see when you wake your laptop).

TIP >>> Once installed, create a MirrorOp shortcut' for easy access later.

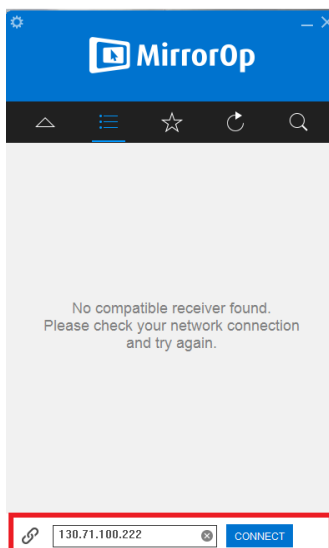
Display your laptop with MirrorOp

Open MirrorOp by clicking on the MirrorOp icon in either your launch bar or your Applications folder.

Ignore the “No compatible receiver found.....” message.

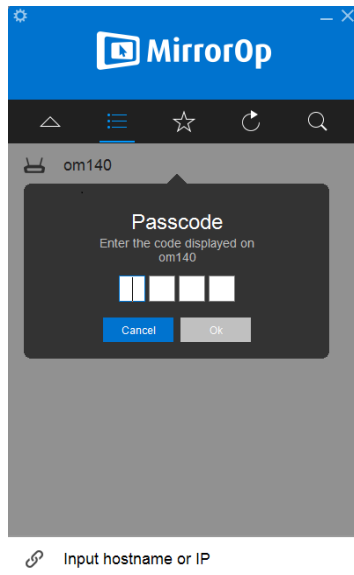
To add a room to your MirrorOp app,

Click on the search bar, at the bottom of the window and type the IP address found at the top of the projected image.



Click the **connect** button to the right of the text field.

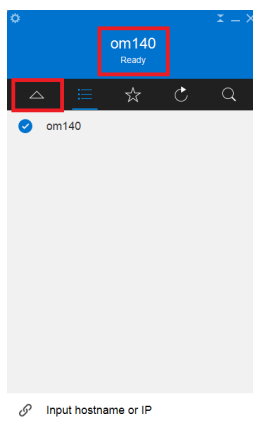
If prompted, enter the four-digit security code displayed in the top right corner of the display.



The name of your device will appear in the list.

TIP >>> If this is a room you might use often, **save it in your FAVORITES list** by clicking on the STAR to the right of the device name. To display your FAVORITES list, click on the blue STAR tab at the top of the window.

Once a room is selected, click on the UP arrow



The MirrorOp window will collapse, displaying a play and stop button. Click on the play button to begin presenting



TIP >>> Up to four devices can show an image on a display at one time. Each user can click on the GRID icon to choose a quadrant of the screen.
