

Notes on the overall quarter grade:

"A" means that the student has met expectations on Number Operations, has corrected all checkins and completed all assignments, worked effectively in class, and either

- received an A on all assessments
- received an "A" on some assessment, an "A-" on other assessments and has completed a significant number of challenge problems.

"A-" means that the student has met expectations on Number Operations, has corrected all checkins and completed all assignments, worked effectively in class, and either

- received an A- on all assessments but has not completed a significant number of challenge problems
- received a "A" or "A-" on some of the assessments, grades in the "B" range for the other assessments, and has completed a significant number of challenge problems

"B+", "B", or "B-" means that the student

- may have needed to correct at least one of the assessments
- may have needed to retake at least one of the assessments but was able to complete the retake without help
- may not yet have met expectations on Number Operations
- may not have completed all required assignments and corrected all checkins
- may not have consistently worked effectively in class

"C" or "D" range means that the student:

- has needed to retake at least one of the assessments and needed help to do the retake or was not able to successfully complete the retake
- may not yet have met expectations on Number Operations
- may not have completed all required assignments and corrected all checkins
- may not have consistently worked effectively in class

A failing grade means that the student:

- may not have not retaken or corrected required assessments
- may not yet have met expectations on Number Operations
- may not have completed all required assignments and corrected all checkins
