Transportation to New York Hilton

From LaGuardia Airport (Queens):

Bus & Subway: LaGuardia Link Q70 bus from Terminals B or C to the Roosevelt Ave/74th Street subway stop and transfer to a Manhattan bound E train to 7th Avenue Station. The NY Hilton is one block walking distance from the stop. The cost of the subway is \$2.90. The ride is about 45 minutes. The frequency of both the Q70 and E train is approximately every 10-20 minutes Monday-Friday. On weekends and holidays, the frequency decreases to approximately every 20-30 minutes.

Rideshare: Lyft/Uber charges from the airport to the destination can range between \$50-\$85 depending on time and traffic. Uber Shuttle to Port Authority or PennStation is also available for a lower rate.

Taxi: A NYC Yellow Taxi has a flat rate charge of \$52 from the airport, plus tolls and tip. There may also be additional surcharges like a congestion pricing fee. You can expect a taxi ride to cost around \$75 total.

Train: Jamaica bound AirTrain to the last stop and a walking transfer to a Penn Station bound Long Island Railroad (LIRR) train (between \$13-\$19). Upon exiting the LIRR, you then take a Queens bound E Train to 7th Avenue (\$2.90) The Hotel is one block away.

This option takes about an hour, excluding wait times for trains. Train frequency ranges from 20-40 minutes and will be longer on weekends and holidays.

Train & Subway: Jamaica bound AirTrain and a walking transfer to a Manhattan bound E Train to 7th Avenue. Cost is \$11.40 one way and the ride takes about an hour. Frequency ranges from 20-30 minutes and will be longer on weekends and holidays.

Rideshare: Lyft/Uber charges can range between \$140-\$160 depending on time and traffic.

Taxi: A NYC Yellow Taxi has a flat rate charge of \$70, plus tolls and tip. There may also be additional surcharges like a congestion pricing fee.

From Newark Liberty International Airport (New Jersey):

Train: AirTrain Newark connects NJ TRANSIT with Newark. One way fare from the airport to NY Penn Station is \$16.80. The ride is about 25 minutes. Frequency is between 10-30 minutes, depending on the time of day. On weekends and holidays, the frequency may be every 1-2 hours. (https://www.njtransit.com/)

Then take the Queens bound E train to the 7th Avenue Station (\$2.90). The hotel is one block away.

Bus: An Express Bus runs between Newark Airport & New York City. The Express Bus runs from 5 a.m. until 1 a.m. daily. The cost is \$22.50 for one way, or \$38.50 for round trip. Buses stop at Port Authority Bus Terminal. You can then take a Queens bound E Train to 7th Avenue (\$2.90) or walk north/northeast for twelve blocks (https://www.coachusa.com/airport-transportation)

Rideshare: Lyft/Uber charges can range between \$45-\$80 depending on time and traffic.

Taxi: A local taxi can average about \$70 from the airport, plus tolls and tip. There may also be additional surcharges like a congestion pricing fee.
