In partnership with St. Louis Community College at Wildwood and the Rockwood School District

## **ACCUPLACER General Information**

St. Louis Community College requires a placement test before any student can enroll (unless an applicant has an official ACT score of Math 19 and English 18). Parkway uses the ACCUPLACER placement test as a criterion in the application process to ensure ECP students will be positioned for success and placed in the appropriate college-level courses.

- The Accuplacer test is an untimed computerized placement test. While some students may finish in 45 minutes, others may take up to 2 hours. Do not rush and take the time that you need to finish and re-check your answers.
- Students must complete a STLCC application before taking the Accuplacer. A STLCC student number (A#) is required to test.
- Option 1: Testing on Campus
  - You may walk in and take the placement test during our open hours. All testing will be stopped 15 minutes prior to closing. The placement test is untimed, but plan for 2 hours for the entire exam.
  - You MUST present a photo identification. No student will be allowed to test if they do not present photo identification. State ID, Driver's license or high school or other school ID are accepted.
  - You will be required to lock up your belongings during the test.

- Option 2: Test either at Home (Virtual Testing) through Examity or test at an approved Accuplacer test site near where you are located
  - Test at a remote site: Accuplacer will be administered at an approved Testing Center near the student's current location. Student is responsible for any testing fee at site.
  - Test at home: Examity Meazure Learning is an external company that is contracted through ACCUPLACER to provide proctor service. Please note the student is responsible for the \$25 \$28 proctoring fee for their service. Students are required to have valid photo identification and a computer with a camera and a microphone. Examity technical requirements
  - To request a voucher for the exam, email your campus testing center (campus where you take
    most of your classes) and provide the following information: Your full name, date of birth,
    Student ID A Number, email address, state of residence, Site location or Virtual and the tests you
    need to complete.
  - The testing center will create a voucher and you will receive an email with further instruction from ACCUPLACER on how to make your appointment, pay the fee and complete your test with Examity Meazure Learning or the offsite location.
  - When your test is completed either at a remote location or online, you will receive your scores and course placement. Please contact the testing center to verify your results have been received by STLCC or if you have any questions. Please allow a minimum of 72 hours to complete test registration, and test taking, and registration into courses.

- Students may walk in and take the placement test during open hours <u>Testing Center hours</u>. If the student is taking the Reading, Writing, and Math potions of the test, plan for the test to take at least 2 hours.
- Free, complete study guides for all subjects can be found at guides.stlcc.edu/accuplacer.
- Students receive their scores immediately following the completion of the test.
- Photo identification is required to test. State ID, driver's license or high school ID are accepted.

- A picture ID is required to test.
- No calculator is needed.
