Cypress Zairn gave a speech during a rally in Arizona. Below is the transcript.

“...You know, [a month, maybe two months ago, President Soccer and Governor Grant gave a speech at this very spot](#). They spoke about what they were doing for Sierra, they spoke about ending homelessness and they cursed the Democrats in the assembly for not rubberstamping their legislation.

“Has it ever occurred to the President, or to the Governor, that perhaps they’re simply not in tune with what the majority of Frémont wants?”

*A loud cheer erupts at the rebuke of Frémont’s loyalty to the Republican establishment.*

“Frémont elected a Democratic majority in the assembly, the most representative branch of the state government. It is the four legislators who have the will of the state. Not the President who isn’t elected in a statewide contest. Not the Governor who doesn’t even govern.

“And it’s no wonder why the people of Frémont reject your legislation, Mr. Governor. It is not anti-homelessness; it is anti-homeless! The Republicans

don't want to eradicate the homelessness epidemic. They'd rather exterminate the very people starving on the streets. Law and order and a senseless war on drugs does not help the homeless. Compassion, and caring, and a sensible legislative program does that.

"Rather than criminalize homelessness, why don't we simply take all of the condemned and repossessed buildings gathering dust and renovate them for use as homes for the homeless? It's an idea which I've proposed myself, before. But the Republicans only think about what they can do to criminalize actions, and not actually fix the issue.

"The President claimed that the Democratic assembly does not govern. I think that's ironic. Where has the Republican majority in the House been all term? Where has the House minority been? And where has the President been, while the Congress passes no bills?

"Nowhere. They've all been nowhere.

"That'll change this next election. Once we oust the Republican majority in the Senate, and once we relieve Adith of his duties, we'll get the Senate and the White House back up and running.
