I am writing to strongly encourage the Board to place a community-wide rental cap proposal on the agenda for a vote by homeowners. The evidence is clear:

- Property Values: A Federal Reserve study and multiple academic reviews show that neighborhoods with higher owner-occupancy rates enjoy stronger, more stable home values.
- **FHA Loan Eligibility**: HUD guidelines make it clear that exceeding 50% investor ownership can disqualify homes from FHA financing, reducing our buyer pool.

I urge the Board to take the next step by preparing a resolution for community vote. An 80% approval is required, and the data makes a compelling case for action.
