Flex- 2025-2026

Student FAQ

- *When is Flex in the 2025-2026 Bell Schedule?*
 - During the 2025-2026 school year, the 30-minute Flex period is being held between [sessions 5 & 6](#). (1:16-1:46)
 - Since Flex is part of the school day, students are to remain on campus.
- *Why is Flex important?*
 - Flex is designed to give students time for:
 - Individualized academic support
 - Enrichment and exploration
 - Managing workload during the school day
 - Strengthening connections with staff and peers
- *Am I assigned a “home base” for Flex?*
 - Yes, every student has been assigned a specific room for Flex, with a specific staff member assigned to each room.
- *What are students expected to do during Flex?*
 - Get extra help from teachers
 - Work on assignments or projects
 - Make up missed work or assessments
 - Participate in academic or enrichment activities
 - Attend clubs or special workshops (if scheduled)
 - Independent reading or study
- *How do I get to see my teachers that I will need assistance from?*
 - EHall pass has an appointment option that students will need to fill out to see a staff member. The teacher will need to accept the pass request.
 - Please see [this video](#) that explains how to properly use an appointment pass.
- *How long do I have to get to my appointment during Flex?*
 - The first **5-minutes** of Flex are designated for students to move to their appointment.
- *Will clubs meet during Flex?*
 - Yes, the first and last Friday of each month are designated for club meetings.

- *Can teachers require me to attend their Flex session?*
 - Yes. Teachers can “pull” students for reteaching, test make-ups, or extra help. Attendance in assigned sessions is **mandatory**.
