

Version 125.0, 126.0, etc monthly version - references, bug reports and misinformation (public)

As of Friday April 24 users are reporting issues against 125.0 build date 20240423 even though we haven't announced that monthly versions are appropriate for users.

https://product-details.mozilla.org/1.0/thunderbird_versions.json does not list 125.0, but it has been found because <https://ftp.mozilla.org/pub/thunderbird/releases/125.0/> and <https://www.thunderbird.net/en-US/thunderbird/releases/> (even though no notes are available).
