2. NEW BUSINESS

● Officials Funding

- Looking for Funding for Ref Program \$1500-\$2000: Developing a program to Develop Officials
MENTORSHIP \$500/ AWARDS \$500/ MEETINGS Under \$500/ DISCRETIONARY \$500
- Mentorship: Older officials working with younger officials but still getting paid the higher level. Younger officials would get to do a higher division game.
- Awards: Senior Officials Award, Junior Officials Award, Most Improved Award (3 Trophies or Plaques and gift like a jersey or sweater) ****Recommends a store from BC designed for Refs**
- Meetings (Off-Ice): 3 Meetings a year, order pizza, go over clips, etc...
- Discretionary Funds: Used for things like if a Ref misplaced a whistle, would be nice if the association could step up and help without putting the Refs at a financial disposition
- Create a Program for our Refs. Hoping to invest in the Officials to help retain them long after they are done playing hockey and show pride in Refing.
- Green light to allow 12 year olds to start Refing, Will do a Ref Clinic.
- \$500 "Discretionary Fund" to get program going
- Great idea to keep kids coming back every year

-This program would be a way to help retain the 12-15 year olds within the program past high school. Idea to have them qualified to Ref all levels of hockey as adults

-Create a program that values their efforts and time
