Basic Information: Date: Sunday, Oct. 26th Time: 5:30-7:30pm

Location: Outside Parking Lot/Picnic Area & Fellowship Hall Portico

Needs & Requirements:

- Everyone:
 - Be present to work/supervise the game & interact with families during the event time period from 5:30 - 7:30pm.
- Trunk or Treat/Game Stations: We need adults & families to volunteer to decorate their car, in a theme they decide, with a game that kids can play during our Fall Festival/Trunk or Treat.
 - Volunteers will need to select a provided game or create their own.
 - Select your theme for decoration/dress up, & decorate your car in a fun way that would be exciting for kids who are participating in the event.
 - Arrive early (around 4:30) and have trunks set up by 5:00pm
- Food Prep & Service:
 - Arrive early (4:30) to help with setup/food preparation
 - Have 1st set of food prepared by 5:00pm so that those with trunks can eat prior to opening.

Games: We have games you can select for this event or you can create your own. It's awesome when games, decorations, costumes, etc. have a cohesive theme.

- Need Help? We have lots of games, decorations, & even costumes that help create a cohesive theme that is exciting and appealing, just let us know what you need ;)
- If you are "renting" a game from church, they will be available in the Fellowship Hall on Sunday Morning prior to the event.
- Your car/station will be assigned parking space(s), you will be instructed where to park upon arrival on Sunday afternoon.

Prizes/Candy: CreeKidz will provide candy for the event. If you would like to supply your own prizes/candy please feel free to do so, just let us know. We will also be collecting candy donations in the weeks leading up to the event (candy donation drop-off bins are located in the Educational Wing Hall by Mrs. Lynn's office)

Prizes for Trunk or Treat Game Cars: There are 3 prizes for Trunk or Treat participants. Trunk or Treat Game Cars should be judged on presentation, creativity, & cohesiveness.

Fall Festival & Trunk or Treat Setup Checklist

Everyone please arrive early (approximately 4:30pm), get in place, & setup by 5:00pm. Food will be available for you to eat prior to the start of the event at 5:30. In addition to trunk setup, below are a few areas where you can help with setup prior to the event.

o Registration/Check-In/Entrance

- o Tent in front of Parking Lot Arrows
 - Weights to hold tents
 - Carnival Flags from Tents to ground stakes (in grass on each side of parking lot)
 - Hay bails, pumpkins, and mums for decoration
- o Table under tent (with Stoney Creek Church logo tablecloth)
 - Registration Tags (1 per family) & Pens
 - Container for completed registration tags
 - Gift Bags (Stuffed with information cards, thank you cards, and glow sticks) – 1 per family (unless extra needed for kids)
- o Check-In station sign

o Trunk or Treat Midway

- o Traffic cones in Place
- o Inflatables (3)
 - Drop cords
 - Stakes
- o Trunk or Treat Cars
 - Arrive Early and get setup by 5:00pm
 - When you arrive, Check-In for your Space # before parking
 - Park in the middle of your two parking spaces with trunks facing the midway

 - Hot Dogs/Drinks
 - Nachos
 - Popcorn
 - Funnel Cakes
- o Drop cords, Fryer, Popcorn Machine, Crock Pots, etc.
- o Trashcan(s)

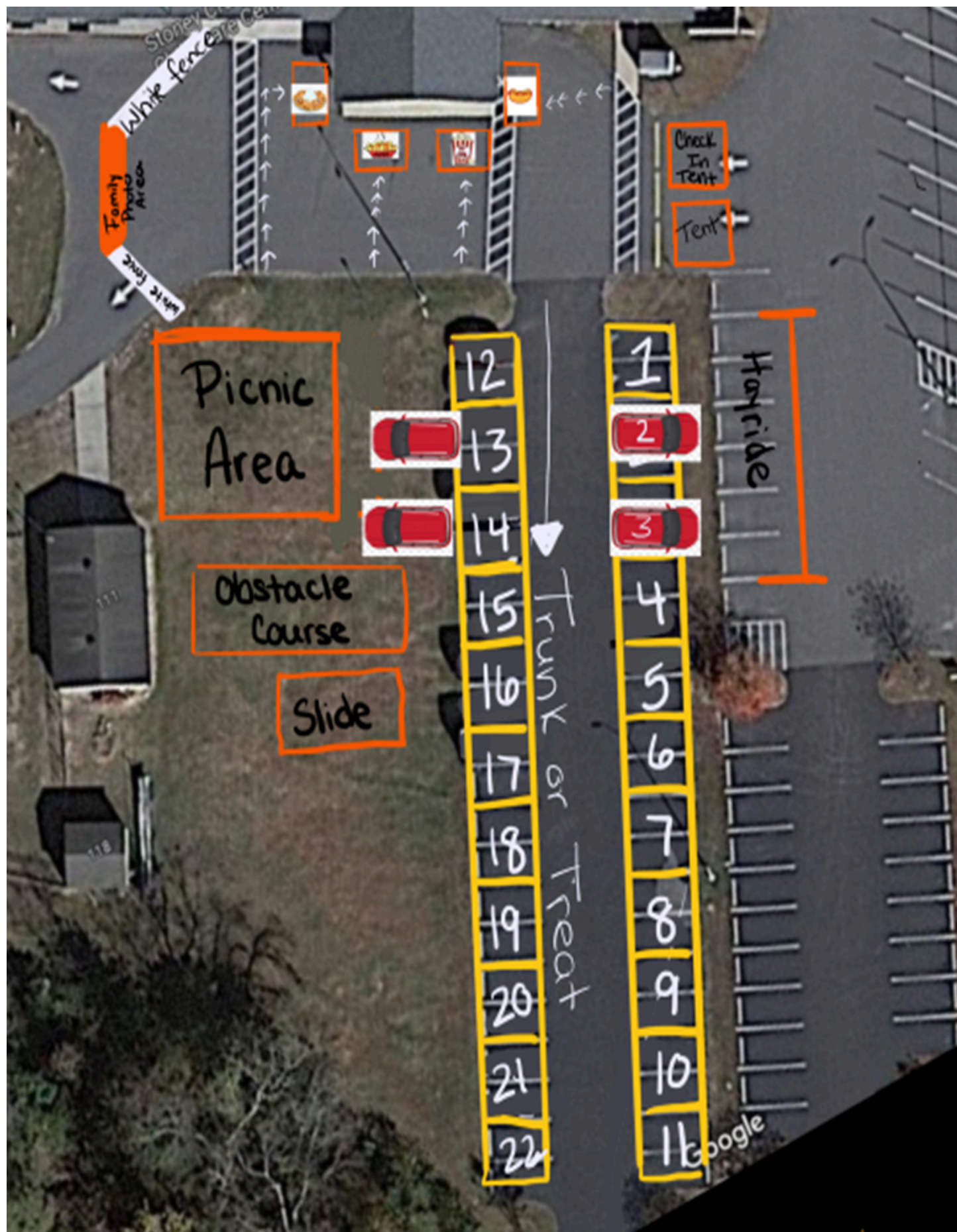
o Picnic Area
