

Ground-Source Heat Pump Disaster Recovery Grant Pilot (July 2023)

Pilot Program Introduction

The Colorado Energy Office (CEO) is pleased to announce a new, streamlined offering to support the adoption of ground-source heat pump technology as part of the CEO's Electrification Rebate Program created through SB22-206. Residential structures lost in state declared disasters since 2018, including from the Marshall Fire, which are rebuilt with qualifying ground-source heat pumps will qualify for a one-time grant of \$10,000 with the Ground-Source Heat Pump Disaster Recovery Rebate.

Rebate Amount:

\$10,000 per household is available if a qualifying ground-source heat pump is installed at a home damaged or destroyed in one of the qualifying state natural disasters after 2018 under [Senate Bill 22-206](#). This grant is additive to any other funding a household may be eligible to receive from state programs.

Ground-Source Heat Pump Qualifications:

The ground-source heat pump system must meet the criteria defined C.R.S. 39-26-732(2)(b), including being designed to supply at least eighty percent of total annual heating for the building.

Additionally, the installing contractor of the loop system must be accredited by the International Ground Source Heat Pump Association (IGSHPA).

How to apply:

Simply provide the information regarding your ground-source heat pump system in the [Electrification Rebate Program Claims Form](#). Below is the information that will need to be provided on the claims form to receive payment:

- Contact information for your general contractor and mechanical contractor
- A copy of the contractor's IGSHPA certification
- Make and model of the heat pump installed at your property
- Documentation that the ground-source heat pump system meets the criteria defined by C.R.S. 39-26-732(2)(b), including being designed to supply at least eighty percent of total annual heating for the building.
- Picture(s) of the data sticker on your geothermal unit(s)
