The phones will be replaced at approximately 1:30 p.m., and switched over to the new system. There is usually a 5 minute downtime during this exchange. Phones would be swapped out during the day. Call One (AT&T), our current vendor is eliminating copper lines, resulting in additional phone costs. Our recommended vendor Comcast, utilizes Fiber and Coax. Note: The service will not be used through the internet. 2018-2019 marks the final year that Lindop will receive E-Rate funding for telephone service, which will result in phone companies lowered pricing.
