

# Philadelphia Public League Officials One Pager

### Requirements

• All officials who wish to officiate Philadelphia Public League (PPL) athletic events must be certified through the Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association (PIAA)

## Required Software

- All officials must be registered on Arbiter Sports in order to be assigned to PPL athletic events, and to receive payment for officiating those events
- If you are not registered on Arbiter Sports, then you will not be paid.

# Assigning

 All officials will be assigned to PPL athletic events by the respective Sport Chair for each sport offered by the PPL

#### Payment

- Beginning in <u>September</u> of each academic/athletic year, all officials <u>will be paid on the 1st and 15th</u>
  of each month
- If the 1st or 15th falls on a weekend or a holiday, then payment will be processed on the next business day
- Officials have until <u>June 30th each academic/athletic year</u>, which marks the end of the School
  District of Philadelphia's fiscal year, to claim any missed payments from any of the previous athletic
  seasons
- After June 30th, no back pay will be processed for the previous academic/athletic year.

#### Communication Policy

The Sport Chair for each respective sport is the primary point of contact concerning all issues
