

EVENT CRASHING POLICY Version 1.0

Active U

General

Event Crashing means attending (or attempting to attend) an Active U event that you are not registered for.

POLICY

Showing up at an Active U event, meeting spot, or carpool location with the intention or hope of attending without being on the official sign-up list (or having prior clearance from the event coordinator) is against our policy. Our event sizes are restricted for a number of reasons, and it is not fair to the event coordinator(s) to show up and ask to attend (putting them, and the group, in an awkward position), nor to any members who may still be on the waiting list who would have liked to attend.

Of course, many of our events take place in public venues, accessible to anyone. If you happen to be in the same place as one of our events, this in itself does not constitute crashing, however, integrating into the event group and participating as a member of the group does. If you are simply participating in the same activity at the same place/time as a group, be sure to participate on your own rather than attempting to integrate with the group.

PROCEDURE

Any member crashing an event they did not register for may result in a warning from the Executive, and a second incident may result in a three-month-suspension of your membership. Any member inviting unregistered guests may result in a warning from the Executive, and a second incident may result in a six-month-suspension of your membership.
