Applications to PA schools are submitted through the Centralized Application Service for Physician Assistants (CASPA).

Most PA Schools will require the following:

- Bachelor's degree
- Patient care experience (500-2000+)
- GRE
- Minimum GPA (3.00)
- Letters of recommendation

Some PA schools require the following:

- CASPER
- Shadowing
- Volunteering
