Race Info:

The Entry Boss race listing <https://entryboss.cc/races/2233> is the main source of standard race information. This Technical Guide is intended to cover non-standard information, particularly transponder fitting, results publication and operation of the **Northern Super Series**.

About Jack McDonough:

Jack McDonough began his cycling career in 1947 with the Brunswick Amateurs. Within three years he had launched into a professional riding career with the Coburg Cycling Club.

The man nicknamed "Mountain Goat" rode 16 Sun Tours, is best remembered for his efforts in leading the 1957 Tour for 7 days before losing the leaders yellow jersey to the legendary Russell Mockridge on the final day. He eventually finished third, but still won the KOM.

In 1970 he joined the Victorian Pedal Club where he taught children the basics of cycling and road safety for more than 20 years.

Jack was a life member of the Coburg Pedal Club, Victorian Pedal Club, Coburg Cycling Club and League of Victorian Wheelmen (now CV) and on the Sun Tour organising committee for more than 10 years.

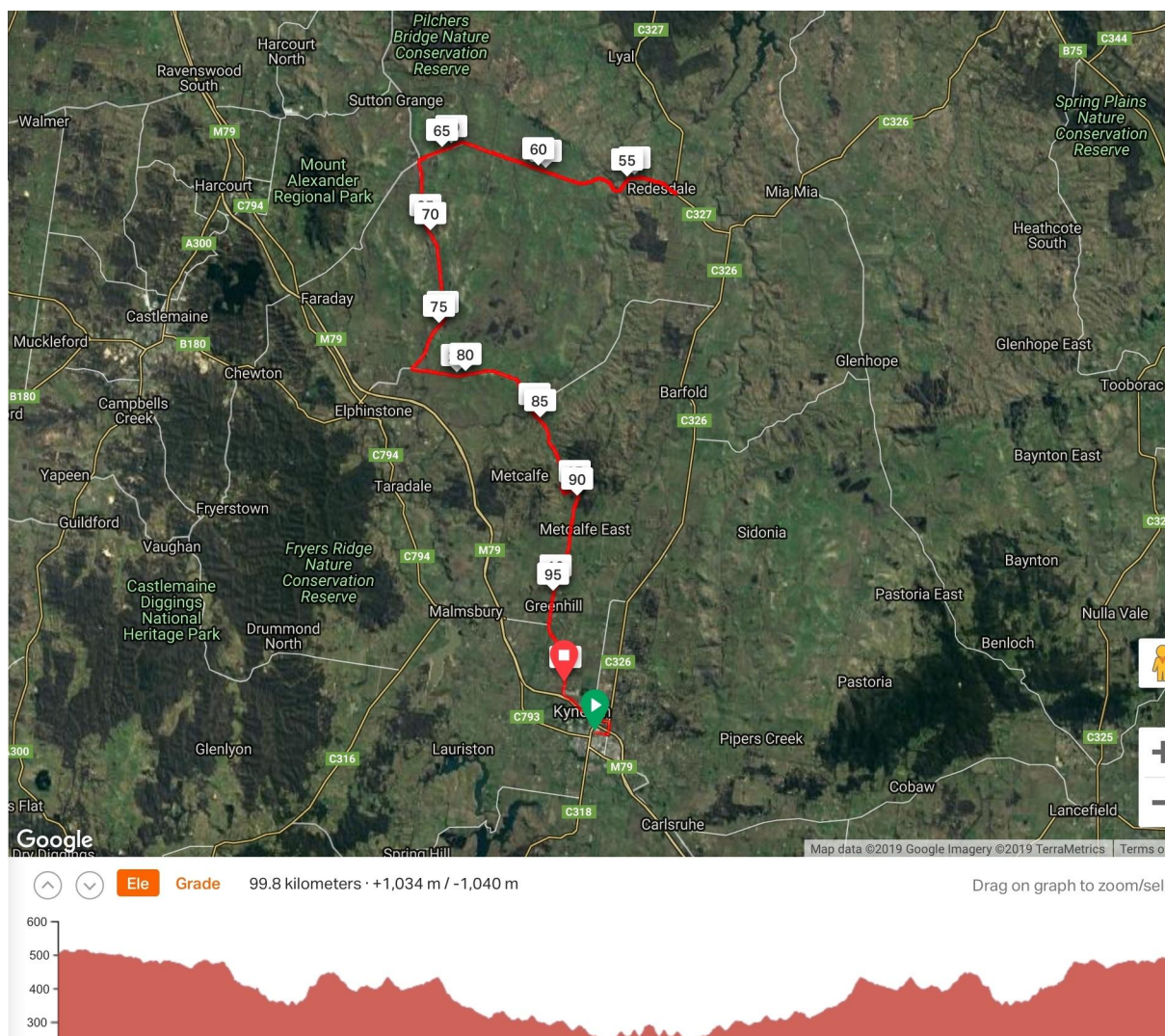

Timing

This race will be transponder timed using Sunbury CC timing equipment.

IMPORTANT: Please mount your transponder on your seatpost like this.



We strongly recommend that you DO NOT USE A FRAME NUMBER HOLDER

Our experience is these frame plates are a little heavy and snap some frame plate holders. Other holders with a single securing screw may see the frameplate rotate into the tyre. Our recommendation is simply to mount to your seatpost. We will provide cable ties and side cutters at Rego.

Other points to note about transponders:

- Please return to rego after race
- No trimming, no modifications.
- If you run a low seatpost and it won't fit, PLAN B is to mount off your seat rails.
- The silver sticker on each side cannot touch metal. If you mount as we ask you won't have a problem
- The transponder is NOT to go on the front fork or in your pocket.
- Cable ties and side cutters will be available at rego.

Northern Super Series

This race will incorporate round one (of three rounds) of the Northern Super Series.

The inaugural **Northern Super Series** will be conducted across three events in April, May and June 2019. The series of timed, full (live*results) events will be run as an aggregate across each grade. Each event is a separate race with its own prize money & prizes. The winner of each grade is determined by the rider who obtains the most points across the series. The events in the series include;

1. Jack McDonough Memorial Road Race (Kyneton) on Saturday 6th April, 2019,
2. Northern Suburbs Three Day Tour (Macedon Ranges) on Saturday 25th and Sunday 26th May, 2019
3. Hell of the West (Balling) on Saturday 29th June, 2019

POINTS

- You receive a point for every rider you beat in each race in your grade;
- You do not get points for starting;
- You do not get points if you do not finish the event.

EXAMPLE

- If there are 31 riders in your grade at the Jack McDonough and you come first, then you accrue 30 points.
- If you came second you would accrue 29 points.
- If you came third you would accrue 28 points.
- Points are awarded until they are exhausted, ie last place finisher is awarded points.

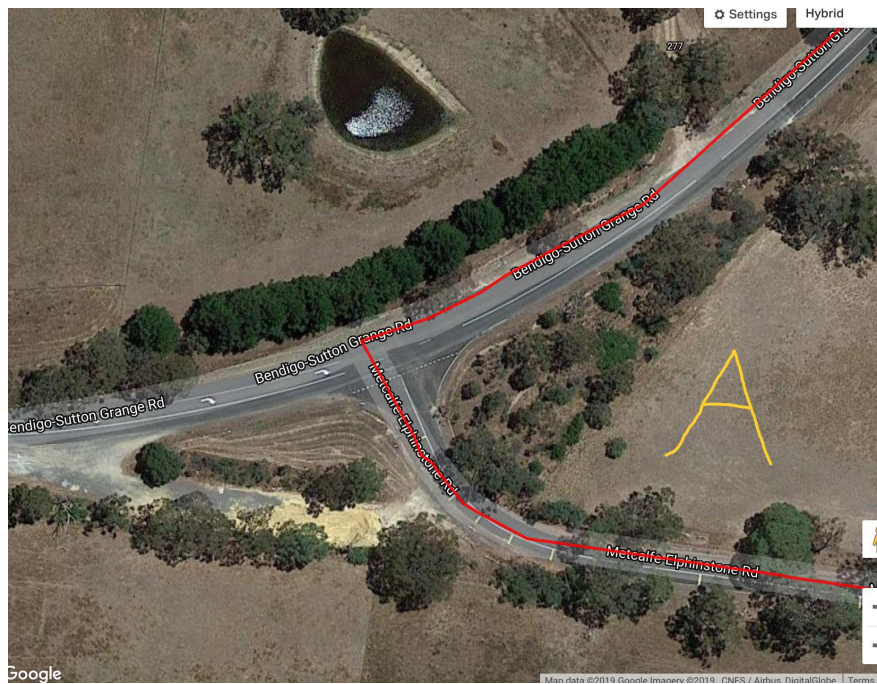
The Course:

The race is neutralised from the Saleyards till the first left hand turn (approx 200m from the Saleyards).



Corner A: as below, 22.5km, all riders turn right onto Bendigo-Sutton Grange Rd, riders will turn left at this intersection on their return.

Only exception is WC and Men E who will perform a U-Turn.





Corner B as below all riders turn RIGHT here on the way out and TURN left here on the way back.



Corner C (Below) all riders go around the round-about and proceed back to corner B, then corner A.



Finish Line (please stay left and do not park at the finish line).
