

Here is some information about the various wait lists that you have been placed on. Remember that this is based on current procedures and past statistics. If you see procedural info that doesn't match what you received from the school, please let me know (they may have updated their process).

The first thing to know is that it's not really a waiting list. It's not ordered. I like to think of it as a "waiting pool".

Timing of Wait List Decisions

In most cases, waitlist decisions will not be made until AFTER May 1. This means that you will need to make a decision about the other schools you have been accepted to, and place a deposit at another school by the deposit deadline.

Most schools will look at their deposit numbers by mid-May, and determine if they will accept additional students off the waitlist. This *can* sometimes stretch on through June and July, but most schools will shrink their waitlist as we move through the summer, leaving a limited number of students on an "extended waitlist".

Who Gets In and Why:

If you're on the waitlist, you've been deemed potentially successful at the school based on your academics, etc - they just don't have the space for everyone. Much of the ability to get off a waitlist relies on institutional needs. They are, for the most part, sculpting their class - based on college within the university, major, your geographic background, financial need (or lack of financial need), and other elements (maybe they need a field hockey goalie because someone just unexpectedly transferred or had a career-ending injury). While you might get in (usually a 3-5% chance, at selective schools), if you don't - it has more to do with them than you, at this point.

What To Do:

Remember to READ the instructions for each school, including any information that you can see in the portals that I can't access. If a school says they don't want something - do not send it.

The most common things to send are: letter of continued interest, 3rd marking period grades

Students who are offered a place on our waitlist will be required to confirm that they wish to continue to be considered for admission should space become available. That process typically does not begin before May 1. Waitlisted students may be admitted to begin in Fall 2022, but we will also have opportunities for waitlisted students to be admitted to programs with Spring 2023 entry in New York and Paris, including the Liberal Studies Core and select majors within the School of Professional Studies, Tandon School of Engineering, and the Steinhardt School of Culture, Education and Human Development. Our waitlist is less than 15% of our applicant pool (105,000 student applicant pool), and is not ranked. **Waitlisted applicants are asked not to send any additional information other than what is requested on the waitlist response form, which we require to be submitted prior to May 1 if they wish to remain on our waitlist.**

The only thing we ask of our applicants is to respond to our waitlist offer online by the date outlined in your waitlist offer letter. You should not submit any new letters of recommendation, writing samples, resumes, certificates, DVDs, CDs, photos, or additional information. Please do not ask anyone to write you an additional letter of recommendation or ask that anyone calls to advocate on your behalf.

You can update us on any new accomplishments and/or relay your level of interest in NYU by way of our Waitlist Response Form online, but you should not submit any new materials whatsoever. Please also understand that given the volume of our applicant pool, we do not interview any candidates for admission and we will be unable to meet with you in person about your status on the waitlist. While you are welcome to visit NYU at any time, please do not make a special visit to campus to discuss your status on the waitlist.
