It was 13 January 1506 when Michelangelo and his friend Giuliano was called by the Pope Julius II to see a sculpture. It was the sculpture of Laocöon. Michelangelo called it a "portento d'arte" and his friend Giuliano said excited "this is Laocöon as described by Pliny the elder!"
