LOGGING IN

All login credentials are in TimeBack. You can simply copy and paste your eGumpp username and password right from there.

Go to the [eGumpp](#) website, and log in to your account with your username and password.

COMPLETING LESSONS

1. Click “Open Module 1”.

eGumpp has four modules that should be completed in sequential order.

If you are in Language Grade 6, you only need to complete Module 1. If you are in Language Grades 7–12, you must complete all modules.

Lesson Details

Each lesson has several components. None of the components should be skipped, and they should be completed in order:

For Module 1:

- Lesson Video
- Lesson Overview
- Tutorial (not graded)
- Lesson Reinforcer (not graded)
- Practice to Mastery (graded)

For Modules 2-4:

- Lesson Video
- Lesson Overview
- Practice to Mastery A (graded)
- Lesson Reinforcer (not graded)
- Practice to Mastery B (graded)

XP allocation varies according to lesson difficulty.

3. Take the Module Mastery Test.

After completing all of the lessons in a module, you should attempt to achieve your best score on the *Module Mastery Test*. You have three attempts on each test.

EARNING UNITS IN EGUMPP

Here's what you need to know about earning units in eGumpp:

- To earn units, you'll need to watch the lesson video, review the lesson overview, practice the tutorial and lesson reinforcer & complete the lesson quiz with a score of 90%+.
- Make sure you work through lessons in order.
- You have completed eGumpp when you've scored 90% or higher on all 42 lessons and 4 Mastery Tests. You have achieved the Mastery level of eGumpp certification (you can check your certificate level on the **Certification page**).

CHECKING YOUR PROGRESS

The best place to check your eGumpp progress is your student dashboard, but you can also use eGumpp to see the work you have completed.

To see how many completed lessons you have, simply log into your account and click into each module.

PRO TIPS

- **Take your time.**

In eGumpp, it's very important that you take your time, stay focused and answer every question thoughtfully. Your patience will pay off!

- **Don't skip around modules or lessons.**

You should not work in multiple modules at once, and you should score 90%+ on each lesson before moving to the next.

- **Use your tools.**

Make sure you're familiar with all of the learning tools that are available in eGumpp:

- **Video lessons:** These introduce the concept.
- **Lesson Overviews:** These highlight the skills you will be learning. Taking notes on the Lesson Overview can be very helpful.
- **Tutorials.**

Taking the time to use these tools will help you learn faster.

- **Learn from your mistakes.**

If you score below 90% on your lesson, that's a great chance to learn! You can go back and review all parts before re-attempting.
