TIME BOARD

Elias Vance (Harrison Ford)

A decorated former field agent turned time board member, Vance is a legend among time
wranglers. He's tough, pragmatic, and distrusts overly theoretical approaches to timeline
protection. Despite his age, he still carries the aura of someone ready to pull a sidearm and jump
into a time breach if needed. Rugged, sharp-eyed and commanding.

Lionel Crest (John Turturro)

Known for his encyclopedic mind and erratic energy, Lionel is a former Preservationist. A genius
at pattern recognition and chaos theory, he's essential for predicting ripple effects of temporal
disruptions. He's both brilliant and exhausting, often talking to himself or quoting centuries-old
philosophers during meetings. Eccentric, wiry, intense.

Lin Yue (Michelle Yeoh)

From the future, Lin Yue is centuries ahead of her fellow Board members in both tech and perspective, but has to keep much of this to herself as not to spoil the future — though the Time Board have oversight of the future more than the majority of TEA staff do. Unlike others focused on short-term fixes, she thinks in "century arcs" — predicting how small decisions ripple far into humanity's fate. Trained in both ancient philosophies and future sciences, she approaches time not as a straight line but as a living ecosystem. She's elegant, composed, and fierce. Mostly lives in her own time period and comes in for time board meetings.

Marianne Sloane (Mary Steenburgen)
