

Roundtable

- Eoinoneill: This week, emmetpdx and I spent a lot of time on the audio branch trying to
 get our build system necessities sorted out. It will take some more time, but basically so
 far so good. We also went through any bugs or mrs we missed while on vacation the
 weeks prior.
- Tiar: I continued working on concentric perspective ellipses I made sure they can be saved and opened, and that the hyperbole can be drawn over the canvas (I haven't added user drawing hyperboles yet, only ellipses work for now) and I made progress in making mirrored image on the other side of the horizon. I reviewed XuChe's MR. I participated in the inherit alpha/clipping masks/layers docker mockups discussions, and I created a few mockups myself. It seems like people like my inherit alpha/clipping masks icons.
- **Xu Che**: Last week I had many reviews on my code and I was fixing them. Also found some other issues with the pixel drawing, like there's a bug with the "Align the brush preview outline to the pixel grid" option, also fixed them. And I decide to extend my GSoC period, because there's still many things left.
- Sharaf: Last week was a bit busy for me because that's when google had approved Krita's update and then the crashes etc started rolling in. So, I had my eyes on them and fixed a couple of crashes, one involving a trivial bug with my KisInputProfileMigrator and

other being more serious -- existence of Chinese text in file path would lead to a crash or so I assumed, but turns out bug was less serious and was only a special case where user deleted the directory in the file manager. I've fixed this bug, but haven't pushed it yet.

I also did some modifications and merged my MR to fix a bug in gradient sliders (!1543), which was reviewed by deif lou.

Finally, I've been looking into a rather serious bug on Android which seem to be happening only on Samsung devices (and in that a limited few getting a crash every few minutes of usage). I posted about this on KA

(https://krita-artists.org/t/crash-when-app-is-moved-into-background-on-samsung-tablets-android-12/46444). But currently, I haven't pinpointed the reason for the crash, so this is something I'm currently looking into.

• Reinold: First I figured out why some types of layers were being skipped (it wasn't it was just passing the group layer code first). Then I spent a lot of time figureing out the kis node visitor and saveContext worked together. I tried to find out why some unintended text was appearing in my svg file. After examining the code for the tiff, jpg, and ora plugins I figured out this was from the saveContext/kostore saving as a zip. I started working on having the visitor interface more directly with the QIODevice. I also did some testing for the android issue shzam posted about on KA. So this week I plan to change the saveContext to use the QIODevice instead of kostore. Also, I think I may request an extension for my project as well but I will have to talk with Wolthera about it.
