

Grading Scale:

The following scale will be used. In order to receive a math credit, students must earn at least 60% overall grade.

- A 90% - 100%
- B 80% - 89%
- C 70% - 79%
- D 60% - 69%
- F 0% - 59%

Grade Distribution:

- 70% Tests & Quizzes
- 30% Classwork & Homework

Assignments:

Assignments will be given (each day of class) over the material discussed. Assignments will be due at the beginning of the next class. Students are expected to complete assignments that are not finished in class for homework. Assignments may be turned in for full credit up till the day of the Chapter Test.

Late Assignments:

If a student fails to turn in an assignment at the time it is due, it is considered late. Students who turn in late assignments after the Chapter test will receive a maximum of 60% of total points.

If you are absent, it is **your responsibility** to get the assignment the first day you return to school. You will have the number of days you were absent plus one day to turn in the assignment for full credit. If it is not turned in during this time frame, it will be considered late

Quizzes:

Short quizzes will be given WEEKLY. The quizzes will be VERY SIMILAR to the homework assigned the previous class periods. You MAY use your homework during the quiz. (This means you should probably spend quality time completing your homework and showing your work!) There will be NO retakes on quizzes so be prepared!

Tests:

Tests will be given over each Chapter. Tests are to be completed in class on the scheduled test date. Tests will be announced prior to the test date. If a student is absent the day before a test, the student will take the test as long as no new material is covered. If a student is absent on the test date then the student will have up to one week to take the test after returning to school, either during class or during Seminar. Students who are absent on the test date will have a 0% entered into the gradebook until the test is made-up.
