The expected start of the race for both days is 9.00 AM, expected end of the races is around 1.00 PM - number of athletes dependent

Athletes	 Athletes on the 2022 - 2023 Provincial Team Athletes that competed at the 2023 Sprint National Championships Athletes who are applying for 2023-2024 Provincial Team/Next Gen Athletes who intend on competing at the 2024 Sprint National Championships All athletes must be +U14 (born 2009 or earlier) unless approved by the Technical Director All Provincial Team Athletes 2022.23 and Athletes who intend to be part of the team for 2023.24 are expected to attend the Camp unless they receive approval from the Technical Director.
Racing distances	"Sprint Long distance": ALL age categories: 3km twice: 1. Staggered start 2. Mass start Winner will be determined by a summary of the placements from both races.
