

Spring / Intersession 2024-2025 Dual Credit Program Information

- Spring/Intersession DCs start End of April and run through June
- Spring/Intersession DCs run twice per week for up to 8 weeks
- Students will earn one full TDSB credit if successful in their dual credit + one college credit
- Intended to assist secondary school students in completing their OSSD and making a successful transition to college and/or apprenticeship programs
- Focus is on students who face significant challenges in completing the requirements for graduation but have the potential to succeed. <u>Dual Credit Fact Sheet / bit.ly/tdsbcollege</u>
- FREE Tuition, supplies, textbooks, and college ID (if applicable)
- Priority of Spring/Intersession courses are given to Grade 12 students, Grade 11 applicants will be put on a waiting list
