Community Relations Subcommittee Working Meeting - MINUTES

Agenda items B and C were discussed together using a chart.

General overarching discussion points included:

- That any posts of new content (including graphics) must be approved by the Chair or by both the Chair and Dr. Harvey depending on the specificity of content.
- Anything posted on social media must be publicly available to anyone.
- The first preference is always to repost content generated by the district (posted on Masco website), and/or create supplemental graphics or explanations of the district-posted content (for example, the “problem solver guide”)
- Would like to promote and explain what is already available, and ask Mike to handle big new topics.
- Consider opportunities for dialogue, based on the portrait of a learner and strategic visioning, to look at Masco’s pathways, competencies and college-readiness with district leadership?
- DESE’s accountability report is available, how can we show community the metrics and data we already have, talk about what the metrics tell us and what Masco is doing to be competitive
- Help community understand what “high needs” means and what the value is for the community of education programs that meet a wide range of student needs (worthy investment for towns)
