OUR INTENTION: The mission of Rotary International and the Rotary Club of Corvallis After 5 is to provide services to others, promote integrity, and advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace through its fellowship of business, professional and community leaders.

OUR GOALS: The Rotary Club of Corvallis After 5 strives to honor our community by supporting efforts to improve education, enhance job training skills, combating hunger, improving health, improving sanitation, and eradicating polio.

The Rotary Club of Corvallis After 5 has the following eligibility requirements that have been established by either regulation or the Board of the Rotary Club of Corvallis After 5.

- Applicants must be a Benton County Registered 501(c)3 non-profit.
- Donations are generally limited to \$1,000 or less.
- Donations are generally limited to once per year or two in three consecutive years.
- We restrict all political donations as provided by law.
- All requests should support the goals as listed above.

APPLY ONLINE - You will be contacted once your application has been reviewed and a decision has been made.

All requests will be considered by the Community Grants Committee and forwarded to the Board for final approval if it is determined that the requests meet the requirements listed above and are consistent with the values and goals of the Rotary Club of Corvallis After 5. Funds are limited and will be awarded on a first come basis.
