Possible process for getting ready for sharing

- 1. What day, time and location will you be sharing?
- 2. Which students will be partnered together?
- 3. Share/review with students, how to give feedback using two stars and a wish.
- 4. When both classes are together and students have their writing in hand, Share today's objective for celebration (celebrate our writing and give some feedback to each other in a kind, respectful, assertive manner.
- 5. Let students know that they can earn class points, individual points, si se puede tickets, etc. by being a kind listener, being a respectful listener, sharing their writing and giving/feedback.
- 6. Pair students up, assign someone to go first to share their writing. (Youngest goes first?)
- 7. Call students' attention. Celebrate what you heard and offer students time to share how they felt
- 8. After sharing, ask students to reflect on the writing they listened to and how the sharing could be better?
- 9. Thank each other, give a class cheer, etc.
