1. Create classrooms

- Organize your students by period or by the time of day that they are with you.

2. Enroll students manually, sync students from Google Classroom or integrate with Clever

- Google Classrooms that are imported into GoGuardian will sync students to make sure all students are in your sessions.
- Manual import can be used for small classes or students that need more or less restrictive scenes than the rest of the class.

3. Add Classroom Owners, Teachers, or Helpers

- Another set of eyes always helps! You don't have to be alone.

4. Run Classroom Sessions to Monitor Student Activity

- There is no reason not to use GoGuardian. It is a tool to help you see what your students are doing. You can't be everywhere at once, and you don't have to be.

5. Set Automatically Scheduled Classroom Sessions

- This allows data to be collected about student browsing even if you are absent or working with individual students. You do not have to set sessions to block any sites to have student browsing data recorded..

6. Issue Commands In Sessions

- Without other students knowing (or without leaving what you are doing) you can redirect individual students in your class.

7. Filter Student Browsing Activity during Sessions with Scenes

- While you can't block everything (wait, yes you can!), you can eliminate many distractions as you guide your students through content mastery.

8. View Data from Past Classroom Sessions

- Want to make your class more engaging, look to see when they were bored, off-task, or frantically working.

9. Generate Student Reports of Browsing Activity

- Show students and their parents how they manage (or don't manage) their online time in your class.
