Overview

The Teach For All + Oak Foundation Inclusive Education Course invites **innovative teachers and teacher coaches** from across our global network and beyond to join an interactive course focused on inclusive education for learners with disabilities and learning differences. The course centers on **who learners are** (awareness; understanding the social, political and cultural context in which students learn and grow, including cultural identities and systemic injustices) and **how they learn** (agency; taking responsibility for one's learning and believing in one's ability to determine a life path and impact others). Through this course, we will individually and collectively reflect on **Culturally Sustaining Pedagogy**, **Universal Design for Learning**, and **Metacognition** to support us in creating reimagined and inclusive environments that allow every child to shine and create a better world for themselves and all of us.

We are excited to share the Inclusive Education Course in <u>English</u>, <u>Arabic</u>, <u>Spanish</u> and <u>French</u> languages. This course is hosted on Bridge.
