Douglas fir 1. Mouse butts in cones 2. Brown/Red buds 3. Bacon bark (old trees) 4. Resin blisters young bark	Red Alder 1. Loose their leaves 2. Leaves have teeth 3. gray/white/blotchy bark
Western Red Cedar 1. Scale or fern like needles 2. Tiny disintegrating cones 3. Red stringy bark 4. Great smell	Sitka Spruce 1. Pokey needles 2. Papery Soft cones 3. Bark like scales
Western Hemlock 1. Tiny Cones 2. Soft Needles 3. Droopy top / Bobbing Branches	Shore Pine Hard cones Two needle bundles Twisty Growth form
