# **IRC Family Council Meeting Minutes**

# March 6, 2024, 7:30 p.m.

## 1. Land Acknowledgment - Danielle

## 2. Treasurer Report - Emma

- Bank account balance currently \$37,146.37
- We just received a cheque from Cookie Dough Fundraiser for \$1,052.
- Balance of just over \$19K after approved expenses.

#### 3. Minutes - Tara

- Secretary reviewed minutes from the previous meeting. **MOTION** - to approve the minutes from meeting of February 7<sup>th</sup>, 024 (Moved by Laura, seconded by Danielle). **MOTION PASSED**.

#### 4. School Wish List - Danielle

- Teachers have been advised that they can spend \$175 each, and they have up to April 12<sup>th</sup> to spend their classroom allocation.
  - There are some outstanding items from the School Wish List that still haven't been approved:
    - Some teacher requests (Ms. Vandermeer, Ms. Oseghale).
    - the Shed approximately \$7000 for a 20 foot container, 3 bike hooks, 2 vents, doesn't include gravel pit. We would need TDSB to put in a gravel pit.
    - Ms. Smith's requested items (which are for use by whole school).
  - Council discussed the additional items that were not yet approved. Council believes we need additional information before making a decision on the shed. As for the teacher requests, there is a total of approximately \$3400 for the additional items on the Wish List that teachers are requesting that we had not yet approved (because we didn't have sufficient details at last meeting).

- Council discussed Ms. Smith's additional requests. It was noted that these additional requests were the result of Council asking Ms. Smith if there were additional supplies she could use when Council was exploring the idea of purchasing more STEAM materials as a potential alternative to doing Scientist in the School. Council has now decided to do Scientist in the School. It was also noted that the first round of approved expenses included about \$1000 in requests for STEAM materials for Ms. Smith. Therefore, it was decided not to approve the additional items for this year.
- MOTION to approve additional teacher requests on the Wish List (see Appendix A) totalling approximately \$3300. No objections. MOTION PASSED.
- Council also discussed the question of whether we need to be putting aside money for the playground replacement/enhancement. With the various administrators coming through the school, we have not yet been able to get anyone to give us an answer on this. ACTION ITEM - Tara to ask questions on the playground of new principal and Erin Althazar.

# 5. Fundraisers for 23/24 school year - Danielle

- April 5<sup>th</sup> Movie Night Danielle. There is a permit for April 5<sup>th</sup>. Movie Night free admission donations at the door. Doors open at 5 pm, and movie at 5:30.
  - Students will be given choices and then vote on the movie to watch
  - o Pizza will be pre-ordered, but we will have a little extra on hand.
  - Popcorn \$250 to buy a popcorn machine, \$400 to rent a popcorn machine. ACTION
    ITEM Danielle to ask principal about whether we could store a popcorn machine if IRC
    Family Council purchases one?
  - Juice boxes, popcorn for sale.
  - Square readers? Emma ordered off the Square site. ACTION ITEM Tara to order a square reader.
  - o **ACTION ITEM** Tara to do an announcement
  - o **ACTION ITEM** Danielle to do a Movie Night poster
  - o **ACTION ITEM** Danielle to ask people to donate snacks
- June 1<sup>st</sup> Fun Fair Laura
  - Updating Council website to ensure we can put Sponsor logos on and there is traffic and link to TDSB website.
  - We have \$7500 in sponsorship, looking for a little more one more sponsor ideally.
  - Gift baskets, silent auction items are some of the next items to focus on.
  - Council discussed volunteers, they are trickling in slowly.
  - Solidifying the vendors is also one of the priorities.
  - Permit for Fun Fair will cost about \$250.
  - Posters discussion about print vs. social.

## 6. Teacher Appreciation - Danielle

- Proposed Teacher Appreciation Event. Idea is to buy some scones and tea/coffee and have an event in the morning in April. To show appreciation for teachers, we would request anonymous quotes from kids talking about the teachers. Parent reps could potentially gather feedback from each class, some quotes from the kids.
