3. Health Monitoring:

Be vigilant for symptoms of heat-related illnesses such as dizziness, weakness, headache, nausea, or excessive sweating. **Do not send your child to school if he/she is unwell.**

4. Healthy Diet:

Provide light and nutritious meals. Include fruits and avoid oily and heavy food during this period. Please note that a fruit break is being provided to students in school to ensure they eat and stay energized during the day. **Students must carry fresh fruits to be consumed during this fruit break.**

5. Awareness and Preparedness:

Talk to your child about the importance of staying hydrated, avoiding direct sunlight, and informing teachers immediately if they feel unwell. **Ensure your child carries a cap to school to protect themselves from direct sunlight.**

The school is also taking all necessary steps, including limiting outdoor activities, ensuring drinking water availability, and spreading awareness among students.

We seek your cooperation in reinforcing these measures at home to safeguard our children during this period of extreme heat.
