



## **2025 Board of Directors Statement of Interest Handout**

### **Director Qualifications:**

In order to qualify for the Board of Directors, you must be an active member of A.A. and have a minimum of two years continuous sobriety on the date elections are held. You also must be 18 years of age or older.

### **Board of Directors Time Commitment:**

- The Intergroup Board is a working board.
- As a Board member, you will actively participate by attending the following meetings:
  - monthly online Board meeting on the fourth Monday from 6:30-8:30 pm;
  - monthly Intergroup meeting on the first Wednesday from 7-8:30 pm (currently online);
  - monthly online Board Committee meeting (date/time TBD);
  - monthly Intergroup service committee meeting as the Board liaison;
  - an annual one-day Board retreat (in-person in August), and
  - Intergroup events/workshops.
- Due to the suggested time commitment of 8 to 10 hours a month for Intergroup meetings and any additional Intergroup work, it is recommended that you discuss this service commitment with your family and your A.A. sponsor.

### **Length of Service:**

The length of service for Board members is three years. Terms begin July 1, 2025 and end June 30, 2028. Directors may serve an additional three-year term.

### **Next Steps:**

*Note: based on the number of vacancies on the Board, Intergroup strives to get double the number of candidates. If needed, Intergroup may push back the deadline if we don't have enough candidates.*

**Timing:**

- **April 1** - Board nominations open - candidates begin submitting their [Statements of Interest](#)
- **May 1** - Board nominations close (unless Intergroup has not received enough candidates).
- **First several weeks in May** - Board candidates must attend a Meet and Greet. This is a chance to meet with other Intergroup Board members, learn more about the commitment and ask questions. If a candidate cannot attend a Meet and Greet, they will not be eligible to move forward in the process.
- **June 4** - Board elections at the annual Intergroup meeting. Before the election, each candidate will have the opportunity to introduce themselves.
