Policy polling: Climate and energy

Policies in blue were presented as Democratic policies, policies in red were presented as Republican policies.

Policy	Net support
Lower the gas tax by 10 cents per gallon	+30%
Declare a national energy emergency	+12%
End policies promoting electric vehicles	+11%
Increase fossil fuel production and make it easier for oil companies to get drilling leases	+9%
Deregulate energy production	+6%
Provide additional tax credits for clean energy investment	-0%
Reduce vehicle emissions standards	-0%
Create a carbon tax and dividend	-8%
Eliminate methane emission fees	-8%
Ban fracking	-9%
Withdraw from the Paris Climate Agreement	-9%
End fossil fuel production on public lands	-10%
Eliminate programs to reduce pollution in low-income areas	-11%
Ban offshore drilling	-14%
Subsidize electric vehicle purchases	-21%
Raise the gas tax by 10 cents per gallon	-40%
