

Dr Asha-Rose Migiro Girls secondary school is located in Mwanga district, the district is found in the south-east of Kilimanjaro Region. The district also is surrounded with Same district, Moshi rural district, Simanjiro District and also along the east border with Republic of Kenya. Asha Rose girls' secondary school is a liberator of the girls' students. It was established in August 20th 1999 as a community based secondary school serving communities in Mwanga district, Kilimanjaro region in Tanzania. Either it was registered as governmental institution officially in 2005 with registration number S.4334 under Ministry of education and vocational training authority. The institution is currently a girls' academic school of more than 300 students.

Mwaga District is mainly dominated by Pare tribe and others like Maasai. The economic activities practiced by Mwanga district people are Subsistence Agriculture, livestock keeping and trade.

Dr Asha-Rose Migiro Girls secondary school aim to educate, inspire, equip and facilitate girls in Mwanga District who are at risk with low education level, poverty, homelessnesness, child labor, sexual exploitation (early marriage, early pregnancy, female genital mutilation at family level and other negative social practices and HIV-AIDS

The School is established to meet the needs of a girl's child Education in the District. It also aims to create a platform on which various players can engage in social activities and especially child girl's education.

The ministry of education and vocational training, science and technology, current education policy of free education for all Primaries and Secondary school education has lead to increase in number of student going to schools. In this respect the number of girls children joining Primary and Secondary schools has also increased. Dr Asha Rose Migiro is within this challenge of getting girls student admission.
