(currently in Grade 9)

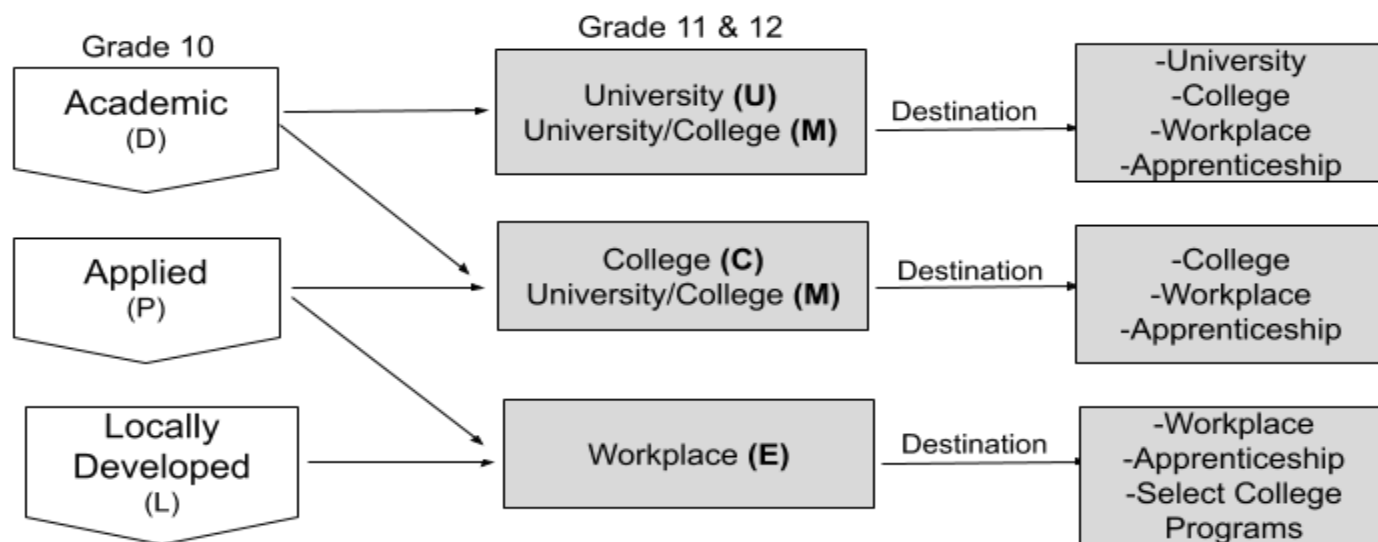
