Course Description

This course is designed to guide students to mastery of the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) for Algebra 2. Students will become proficient in the use of the TI 83+ graphing calculator. Algebra 2 topics include the following:

Inverse and Radical Functions and Relations
Exponential and Logarithmic Functions and Relations
Rational Functions and Relations
Conic Sections
Sequences and Series
Statistics and Probability
Trigonometric Functions
Trigonometric Identities and Equations

Grading Procedures

Homework. Practice of a skill or concept is necessary to learning. Homework related to the lessons will be assigned on a regular basis. All work should be shown on homework...not just the answers. Late papers will be accepted following the procedure outlined in the student handbook.

Quizzes will usually be unannounced and administered as appropriate.

Major tests are announced and a review is provided before administration.

Six-week average. The six week average will be computed using the following ratios.

40% The average of class work, homework, and quizzes.

60% The average of the major tests given in the nine week period.

Semester Average. The semester average will be computed using the following ratios.

- 3/7 1st nine week average
- 3/7 2nd nine week average
- 1/7 Final Exam-assesses all concepts for the semester.
