Honors Program Late Work and Make-up Policy 2025-2026

Students in Model High School's Honors Program taking Honors, Advanced Placement (AP), or Dual Enrollment (DE) classes are part of a more rigorous curriculum with higher expectations.

Honors students are expected to do the following:

- 1. **Turn in all assignments on time.** Work is considered on time if completed and submitted on the assigned date and time.
- Be responsible for their assignments. If a student is absent, it is their responsibility to obtain the missed assignments from each teacher. If the absence is excused, the student has <u>three days</u> from their return to complete and submit the work.
- 3. When absent, complete all assignments for each honors class. Homework, tests, and/or projects due on or after the student returns from an absence will be enforced if the student was made aware of the due dates before their absence.
- 4. **Tests cannot be retaken or corrected.** Students should ensure they are well-prepared for tests and quizzes before the day of the assessment.

Consequences for late work:

Zeros are given for missing assignments and cannot be made up.
