OASIS Degree Worksheets

[OASIS](#) (Online Advising Student Information System) provides tools and services to help you throughout your academic career at UC Davis. This system provides GPA tools to understand your academic performance and track your progress through degree worksheets.

How to use the OASIS Degree Worksheets

1. Log on to [OASIS](#) with your kerberos ID and password.
2. Locate your Academic Record to view current and past course enrollments, units, and grades.
3. Locate the Degree Worksheets tab and create a New Worksheet under your corresponding study track (12-month, 2-year).
4. Use the Core Courses section to add in the required EPM courses (ENV 200A, ENV 200B, ENV 200CN, ENV 201, ENV 202, ENV 203A, ENV 203B, ENV 203P, ENV 297, ENV 296).
 - a. Select the Core Courses drop down menu to make your selections by clicking on each course.
5. Select the elective courses you plan to use to fulfill the Quantitative and Environmental Justice elective requirements.
6. While Specializations are optional, you may use this section to add in classes you plan to use towards your [specialization](#).
 - a. Remember, a specialization requires 9 units of coursework, in which 4 must be at the graduate level.
7. The [program coordinator](#) will confirm that your specialization classes have been met and will note this in the Notes section of the worksheet.
8. Don't forget to save your worksheet after making edits!
