

"Good evening. This is [CALLSIGN] calling this session of the University of Cincinnati Amateur Radio Club Net to order."

[break]

"This net is open to all licensed amateurs and is sponsored by the University of Cincinnati Amateur Radio Club. This is a directed net and Net Control will direct and control all activities and traffic for the duration of the net this evening."

[break]

"Your net control for this session is [CALLSIGN], my name is [NAME] and I am located in [LOCATION]."

<pause>

"This net meets every Tuesday evening at 5:00 p.m. local time on the 147.06+ W8YX repeater at the University of Cincinnati. This repeater requires a 100 Hz PL tone for access. It also transmits a 100 Hz PL tone."

<pause>

"The purpose of this net is to pass traffic and announcements relevant to the University of Cincinnati Amateur Radio Club and provide a forum for promoting activities and discussion of interest to net participants."

<pause>

"When checking in, please give your callsign, repeat your callsign phonetically, then give your name and location. Also indicate whether or not you have any announcements, questions, or other traffic for the net."

<pause>

"At this time, if there is any emergency, priority, or time-valued traffic for the net, please call [CALLSIGN] now."

<wait for calls>

<handle traffic as necessary>

"Are there any mobile, portable, or short-of-time stations wishing to check in? Please call Net Control now."

<wait for calls>

"I will now begin to take regular check-ins. When checking in, please give your callsign, repeat your callsign phonetically, then your name, location, and whether or not you have any traffic for the net. If there are any other stations wishing to check in to the University of Cincinnati Amateur Radio Club net, please call [CALLSIGN] now."

<wait for calls>

<handle announcements, questions, and other net business that may come up>

<Call for late check-ins>

<Move to round-table, trivia, etc>

<Direct comment round, calling each station and asking for comments individually>

<Call for late check-ins>

<Call for other traffic (comments, announcements)>

CLOSING THE NET:

Before closing the net, ask for additional comments, announcements, or late check-ins and count the total check-ins.

<wait for calls>

<handle traffic>

"This net is now closed at [TIME] local time with [COUNT] check-ins. Net control would like to thank all those who checked in to the University of Cincinnati Amateur Radio Club net and remind you to check in again next week on Tuesday at 5:00 p.m. local time."

<pause>

"73, this is [CALLSIGN] signing off and returning the frequency to normal and customary amateur use. 73!"
